Could your child be eligible for extra support?

Free School Meals

Why apply?

Even if your child already receives free meals, registering helps the school receive additional funding to support learning, resources and opportunities.



Early Years Pupil Premium

Who can apply?

Children aged 2, 3 or 4 attending a maintained nursery full day may be eligible if parents or carers receive qualifying benefits.

Early Years Pupil Premium provides extra funding to improve education for eligible children aged 3 and 4, including children who are or have been looked after.

Reception, Year 1 and Year 2

All children receive free school meals. If parents or carers receive qualifying benefits, applying helps the school receive additional Pupil Premium funding.

Year 3 to Year 11

Children may be eligible for free school meals if parents or carers receive qualifying benefits.

Applying also supports the school through Pupil Premium funding.
